Rationale for Motion and Expected Benefit to CISV if the Motion is Passed

By law, we are required to have our accounts audited. Robson Laidler audited our accounts for the 2015 financial year. They were appointed by the Governing Board following the resignation of the previous auditors, who advised that they were gradually withdrawing from that type of work.

Robson Laidler is now familiar with our organization; they were very efficient and have offered a three-year price guarantee. It is recommended that they continue as CISV International's auditor.

Our Articles of Association provide for the appointment of auditors annually by the Members. In light of MtnO2-Virtual Discussion and Voting by Members – Motion Nov 2016, we may be moving to one planned virtual voting window per year with draft motions to be ready by late March. That would be before the accounts for the previous year would be ready. In addition, it is general practice to work with the same auditors for several years and in our case, we have been given a price guarantee for auditing services that will take us through the audit of the 2017 financial year. We believe, therefore, that it would be more practical for all concerned to ask the Members to approve this appointment now for both the 2016 and 2017 financial years. The 2017 accounts would be published and ready to be received at the General Meeting of the Members to be held at the 2018 Global Conference. At that time, the Members would also be asked to appoint auditors for the future.
